

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Please be advised that a public hearing will be held in the Auxiliary Courtroom, at 2700 Johnson Street, Greenville, Texas, dates listed at end of notice, to discuss and possibly take action on:

1. A tax rate of \$0.532469 per \$100 valuation has been proposed for adoption by the governing body of Hunt County. This rate exceeds the lower of the effective or rollback tax rate, and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$0.532469 per \$100

PRECEDING YEAR'S TAX RATE \$0.532469 per \$100

EFFECTIVE TAX RATE \$0.518312 per \$100

ROLLBACK TAX RATE \$0.565251 per \$100

The effective tax rate is the total tax rate needed to raise the same amount of property tax revenue for Hunt County from the same properties in both the 2014-2015 tax year and the 2015-2016 tax year.

The rollback tax rate is the highest tax rate that Hunt County may adopt before voters are entitled to petition for an election to limit the rate that may be approved to the rollback rate.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE ABOVE RATES CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS:

$$\text{property tax amount} = (\text{rate}) \times (\text{taxable value of your property}) / 100$$
