

# PERMITS REQUIRED IN HUNT COUNTY

---

1. CULVERT PERMITS
2. ON-SITE SEWAGE PERMITS
3. DEVELOPMENT PERMITS \*Needs to be obtained before starting anything defined as development.

“Development” – Means any man-made change to improved and unimproved real estate, including but not limited to buildings or other structures, mining, dredging, filling, grading, paving, excavation or drilling operations or storage of equipment or materials.

\*Same as a building permit, but does not controlling what's being built, but where it's being built. If in a floodplain, then we control where and how and other permits relating to FEMA regulations.
